



Section of Core 3 (1785.2 - 1790.1m): Pretty Hill Formation - Crayfish Subgroup.
A typical section of core at this level. The rock is extremely friable siltstone and the core has fractured apart at regular intervals. Frequent laminae of light grey sandstone exist here with resultant flame structures evident throughout the core. Cross bedding and erosional surfaces can be observed, along with sections of more massive unfeatured siltstone.
