

✓REPORT ON CORE 18, PORT CAMPBELL NO. 2 WELL

Several specimens of core 18, Port Campbell No. 2 well were prepared for palynological examination. However, no plant microfossils were observed in any of the resultant residues. These observations confirm those recorded previously by Evans (1961) and Dettmann (1964) that the sediments cut by core 18 in Port Campbell No. 2 well are devoid of plant micro-organisms.
